



# Welcome to King's Way Christian School's Kindergarten Preview!

## Answers to the most frequently asked questions for kindergarten...

### **What is the birthday cut off for kindergarten?**

All kindergarten students must be 5 by August 31, 2010.

### **How many students are in a kindergarten class?**

We currently offer 4 classes with 18 students each. Two classes are in the morning (8:30 - 11:15) and two are in the afternoon (12:15 - 3:00). We are surveying parents for interest in adding a full day class for another option.

### **Can I request an AM or PM class?**

You may attach your written request to the back of your child's application. Keep in mind that most requests are for the AM classes and that we do our best to accommodate schedules while still balancing out classrooms.

### **If my child is presently attending KW's preschool and will be 5 by Aug. 31st, is he/she guaranteed a place in next year's kindergarten class?**

King's Way pre-school students have first enrollment privileges. Final placement, however, is determined by readiness.

### **How is it determined if my child is ready for kindergarten?**

We have developed a screening/assessment process that has proven to be very successful in determining a child's readiness for kindergarten. The assessment dates are April 28, 29 and June 14. You may schedule your assessment date/time when you register.

### **How can I help my child get ready for the assessment process?**

Readiness for kindergarten is a developmental process (maturing process). Children develop at differing rates and in different ways. This assessment will let us know if students are ready for our kindergarten program. Parents will receive information on areas to strengthen over the summer.

### **What if my child is not ready for kindergarten? I want more than just another year of preschool. What do we do?**

The Learning Center has developed an excellent pre-K program that has proven to be a real blessing to our families. Information may be attained at the Learning Center.

### **Will I receive my registration and testing fee back if my child's assessment encourages that he/she needs to wait another year?**

Your registration fee will be refunded or credited to your current account. The \$25 testing fee is non-refundable since testing has already occurred.

### **Are KW teachers certified and is the school accredited?**

All our classroom teachers are WA state certified teachers. Our school is accredited through NAAS (Northwest Association of Accredited Schools) and members of ACSI (Association of Christian Schools International).
