King's Way Christian High School is committed to a biblical philosophy of education which integrates Christian principles and scriptural truths with the academic and social experiences of every student.

We desire to enroll students who will exhibit the biblical values of showing care and concern for others in our school community as well as an enthusiasm for the learning process. Students seeking admission are evaluated on the basis of their report cards, references, admission questionnaires, interviews, and potential to perform satisfactorily at King's Way Christian High School. Admission is also dependent upon evidence that the student's most recent schooling experience has been successful, both academically and behaviorally.

❖ ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Registration for high school starts March 1, 2011. Please return your application along with your registration fee to the high school office.
- Submit the three recommendation forms to current teachers and principal.
- Complete the Student & Parent Statement form.
- Submit a current report card or transcript.
- Complete admissions test (or submit current MAP testing results)
- An interview with the Academic Dean may be required before acceptance.

❖ TUITION AND FEES

- Registration fees: \$210 through April 30, 2011 (\$260 after April 30th)
- Tuition: \$7.325 (see rate sheet for payment plans available)
- High school books are additional (estimate of \$300-\$400). A book list will be available in June. For your convenience, our list of textbooks will be available for purchase in August through an online bookstore company, Studysource.com. A textbook buy-back is then held at the end of the year. Feel free to contact current students to purchase their used books.
