

High School Booklist 2019-2020 Notes

Below are very important notes about textbooks, our online store, purchasing books from the internet and how to do it early! To find the courses you have been approved for (the schedule is not available until late August) please go to your Blackbaud Family access and log into your account. See Course Requests under My Day.

10th & 11th grade students: Do not purchase your Bible course books until August 1st as the schedule is still being finalized and your choice may end up being your alternate course.

Our online bookstore: Before school starts, students will need to purchase their ebooks through our online bookstore which will open on August 5th. This online store will make it a one-stop-shopping experience for students purchasing ebooks and will provide options for purchasing print books. We will send out another notification before the bookstore opens with instructions on how to purchase ebooks and/or print textbooks on their website.

Buy print books EARLY: Print books may also be purchased on the internet through [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com) or other vendors. This is usually less expensive than the online bookstore when it comes to print books. It is advisable to start shopping online for some of the print books this month before the online bookstore opens. When doing this option please be watchful of the ISBN numbers listed on the booklist.

Chemistry: We have almost enough loaner books left from previous students for everyone to have one this year, so please reserve your book now by emailing Mrs. Coval (ValCoval@kwcs.org). You may also purchase your own book with the ISBN # on the booklist.

Pre-AP Chemistry: You should be able to find this textbook inexpensively on the internet. We do have a few loaners, so please email Mrs. Coval (ValCoval@kwcs.org) to check if we still have some available.

Environmental Science: This is a “new to KW” print edition this year. Shop early for the best price!

AP World History: This is a “new to KW” print edition this year. Shop early for the best price!

AP US Gov’t & Politics: Please note there is a supplemental textbook on the list this year. For the returning textbook, we do have a few loaners if needed, please email Mrs. Coval (ValCoval@kwcs.org).

Spanish workbooks: For convenience again this year we have purchased in bulk all of the High School Spanish workbooks and will distribute them to students in their Spanish class on the first day of school. This will alleviate previous issues with backorders. Each student’s tuition account will be charged \$22.

Math fee: The digital access fee for Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2 and Applied Math is \$35. The fee for Precalculus is \$75. AP Calculus doesn’t have a fee (using in-class materials). These fees will be added to each student’s account in September.

Course fees: These courses have additional fees per semester class and will be added to a student’s tuition account: Art and Pottery \$10, Graphic Design \$75.

Reminder: All students need to have their own laptop or Chromebook to use daily in the classroom.
