

# 11TH GRADE Calendar

## ALL YEAR

- Take the most challenging courses you can to demonstrate your readiness for college
- Engage in leadership, volunteer in service organizations and athletic teams that are aligned with your interests
- Demonstrate interest to the colleges that you are seriously considering by visiting, checking out their booths in college fairs (in-person & virtual), and contacting their admissions offices

## FALL SEMESTER

### October

- Start of the semester with good academic standing
- Get familiar with Naviance
- Take the PSAT NMSQT Exam
- Attend the College Fair for Sophomore, Juniors and Seniors
- Register for the SAT Test (If you are considering taking the SAT more than once)

### November

- Registration deadline for SAT Test
- Schedule to meet with King's Way Christian High School College Advisor for General Check in
- Register for AP exams

### December

- SAT Test administered
- While SAT Subject Tests are not required, some campuses recommend that freshman applicants interested in competitive majors take the tests to demonstrate subject proficiency.

## SPRING SEMESTER

### January

- Fill out the College Planning Survey for Juniors

### February

- Register for AP exams
- Sign up for Career Day
- Complete Naviance Assessment

### February-April

- Meet with your college advisor to initiate college planning - discuss personal goals and preferences, initiate a first version of your college list, discuss future standardized testing based upon your PSAT (or December SAT) results, and decide on next steps



February-June

- Research colleges suggested by your college advisor – read college guides, visit websites, speak with friends, family, KWCS faculty, and alumni – and review the options with your family
- Visit colleges during school school breaks

March

- Prepare for SAT
- Attend Career Day

April

- Attend Junior Parent Night to learn more about college admissions process
- Visit colleges during spring break

May

- Take the Advanced Placement (AP) exams

May-June

- Register with [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) for scholarship information
- SAT exam administered
- Complete the Naviance Evaluation Survey

**SUMMER**

- Visit colleges as recommended by your college counselor.
- Read a few books to grow your relationship with Jesus, your leadership, and your knowledge of college! Keep your mind engaged.
